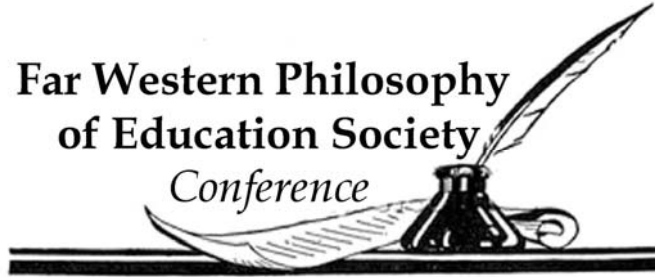


# Call for Papers

**Theme:** The focus of this year's conference is exploring the ideologies of educational theory and practice in the post-millennial and trans-cultural age. In particular, how does (or can) education contribute to the development of wise citizens who demonstrate independent and critical thinking and problem-solving, recognize their social responsibility to the broader demands of citizenship, and enter into a community of common concern and constructive social responsibility?
